

What Materials Are Veneers Made of?

Dental Veneers are used to repair and improve appearance of patients teeth. They are custom fitted shells that cover the surface of teeth. Veneers are typically used to repair chips, repair tooth damage, hide cosmetic imperfections, and used on front teeth to alter their shape or length.



Porcelain (Traditional Veneers)

- Strength comparable to natural teeth and enamel
- Aesthetics look like natural tooth
- Approximately 10 year lifespan or longer
- Color-matched to teeth
- Highly stain resistant

Composite Veneers (Bonded Veneers)

- Made of resin compound material
- Natural, smooth appearance
- 5-10 year lifespan
- Weaker material than porcelain
- Quicker procedure than porcelain
- May become stained
- Can be reversed
